Behavioral Management Skills Development (BMS)

This program entails providing services for children and adolescents (Ages 4-21) with psychological, emotional, behavioral, neurobiological and/or substance abuse problems within the home, community, and/or school, when such problems are of such severity that highly supportive and structured therapeutic behavior interventions are required. Behavioral Management Skills Development services are delivered to consumers who are in need of interventions to avoid inpatient hospitalizations, residential treatment or separation from his/her family; or, who require continued intensive or supportive services following hospitalization or out-of-home placement as a transition to maintain the consumer in the least restrictive environment possible.
